

# CHS Choir Booster Meeting Minutes

## Minutes

- Minutes of the September 22 booster meeting were distributed and read by those in attendance.
- Kim Clash motioned to approve the minutes and Scott McQuaig seconded the motion. Minutes were approved.

## Treasurer's Report

- Kim C. mentioned that money has only been spent on shelves and the picnic up to this point.
- The money budgeted for purchasing robes has not yet been spent. This will be revisited in the spring so robes can be ordered and available for the beginning of the 2015-2016 school year.
- Heather Kronheim motioned to approve the report and Kris Young seconded the motion. The treasurer's report was approved.

## Fundraisers

- The Keystone fundraiser that had been presented by Lynda Morris at the previous meeting was discussed. This fundraiser didn't happen this year due to lack of participants. It was decided that we will revisit this fundraising possibility at our May meeting in 2015.
- The fruit fundraiser has been sent out and the money and order forms are due on Friday, November 21. The fruit fundraiser will be delivered to the school on December 15 around noon for an afterschool pickup. Help will be needed to sort orders. Heather will send out an email asking for volunteers.

## Concerts

- The first concert is Tuesday, November 18 at 7 PM in the Swartz Auditorium.
- County Chorus concert is Tuesday, November 25 at 7 PM at Shippensburg High School.
- Although no one who auditioned actually made it to districts, the school is able to send one student, which will be Michael Anderson.
- Musical Revue will be December 12 at 7 PM in the Swartz Auditorium.

## Bake Sale

- We will have bake sales for choir only events (Musical Revue, Musical, and Spring Concert)
- We need to get someone to volunteer to coordinate the bake sales. Heather will ask for a volunteer in the email going out to parents.

## Musical

- Dan announced that the musical this year will be “The Music Man”.
- Dan also will contact Culinary Arts to see if they would be interested in catering a dinner for cast members and families prior to the Saturday performance. If they are not interested, then the dinner idea will be dropped.
- The following musical committees will need to be formed: costumes, sets (construction), flowers/water, program, bake sale, and music apparel. Kim F. will head up costumes, Kim C. will handle programs, and Scott will head up the set committee.
- The musical budget was discussed and a quick budget was put together. In the discussion it was noted that we will likely be renting costumes from CV. There was also a need for a higher choreography budget, since we will need additional staff to help with dances.
- The Patron Project was also discussed, and it was decided that we would have the meeting at 7:30 PM, after the next brief booster meeting on December 15. Kim C. will present the project, and all money and ads will go directly to her. However, Dan will coordinate the list, to allow students to sign up during the school day. It was also discussed setting a limit on how many ads a person could sign up for originally, due to the large number of students involved in the musical this year.

Heather motioned to adjourn and Kim C. seconded the motion. The motion was approved, and the meeting ended at 8:05 PM.
